Program for Support of Young Authors' Attendance at IFAC Symposia

as approved by the IFAC Foundation Board of Trustees on July 7, 2008.

According to this Program, the IFAC Foundation is open to consider applications for support of young authors' attendance at the IFAC Symposia to be held in 2009 and 2010.

The NOC Chairperson of the symposium interested in the Program should contact the IFAC Foundation.

Eligible for support are authors of accepted technical papers – citizens of a developing country – whose age will be less than 30 years during the conference. Only one author per paper can be supported.

A developing country is understood to be one which not on the attached list of high income countries.

The support consists of a lump sum to help defray the cost of registration, accommodation and travel expenses related to the symposium.

Applications should be addressed to the NOC Chairperson by the eligible authors.

A presentation of the paper at the conference by the winner of the support is a requisite for support.
